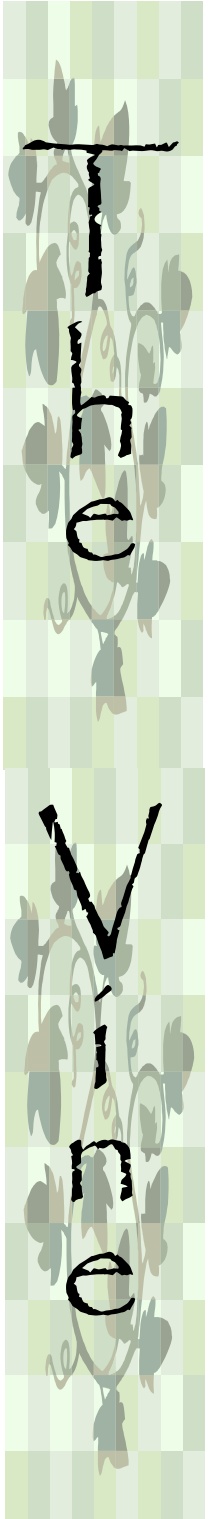
SPECIAL MINISTRY TEAM MEETING
