Once 'twas constant drifting, now my anchor's cast.*

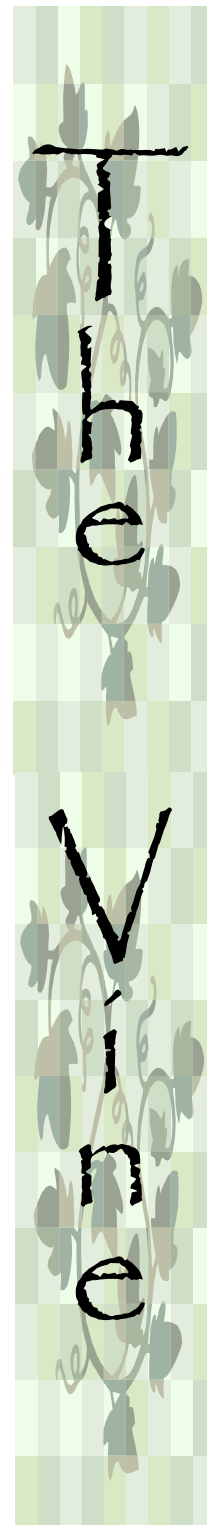
*Once 'twas busy planning, now 'tis trustful prayer;

SHARING 2012—INSTALLMENT THREE . . . "WHAT?"

What has been handed off to us by Jesus in the Great Commission of Matthew 28? Can we really know and understand it? We were given one clear command, not an option—'go make disciples.'

We have wrongly let people believe that you become a Christian and then have two options.

Those options after salvation are minimal commitment or become a completely devoted follower of Christ. Just obtain your 'get out of hell' card and then fit your new beliefs into your lifestyle somehow. Also a new category was created of super Christians and led people to believe this is a disciple. They are highly educated or memorized the entire Bible, you know, a standard few can reach.

Few churches have identified what a disciple is and communicated it. Few have developed a systematic approach to help discover discipleship and evaluate progress for the individual. The result is ministries without enough disciplemakers, leaders, ministry workers, finances or you add the others.

Creating disciples is the key component to Christ's command to set the stage for ministry and evaluation. People are a disciple when they become a Christian. 'Disciple' is the thing we are to be making. It is easier to count money or attendance than to wrestle with 'Are we making disciples?'

The fullness of making disciples requires us to baptize, or cement everyone into union and commitment to Christ. Teach to observe all that Christ commanded. Teach and emphasize everything that Christ had a passion for, a priority for, and a devotion to. Disciples must learn what it means to love God and people with all their heart, soul, mind and strength.
