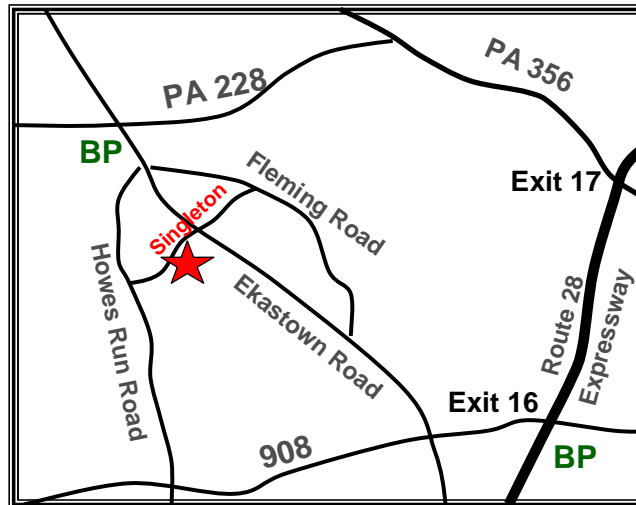

## God's Distinct Grace and Calling

Christ Community is working to build:

**A Community of Believers**—experiencing and sharing a real, growing relationship with the Living God, learning to love Him and love one another.

**A Climate for Relationships**—establishing a relational environment of grace and mutual encouragement for personal, spiritual formation and growth toward Christlikeness.

**A Co-op of Ministries**—fostering and facilitating partnerships, training, and the support needed to serve people and to advance His Kingdom.

**A Campus for Connection**—housing and supporting a growing number of interpersonal, family, church, and community ministries—a place to experience God and His grace.

Through the years ahead, we are trusting God for His guidance and provision as—

1. We will pray, plan, and initiate a broadening number of creative ministry efforts and groups.
2. We will plan and add the support staffing to manage and care for this campus and to administer the work.
3. We will, over the years that follow, plan, finance, and add those structures that will outfit Christ Community for a full and diverse ministry. These will include a multi-purpose, technically supported auditorium; an inviting, comfortable greeting and information hall; a full kitchen; and a computer lab and learning center. Perimeter grounds and gardens, walkways, and amphitheater will be part of the future outdoor development.

## Opportunities at Christ Community

**SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP**—a distinct combination of singing, praise, testimony, drama, meditative, and learning experiences that are Bible-based and practically aimed to deepen our knowledge and full life worship of and love for God. Nursery and age-level classes provided.

**FAMILY AND CHILDREN**—Parents are supported in their child-rearing role by our 2+52 Children's Program. Sunday morning praise, learning, and fun are the centerpiece of this team's ministry.

**STUDENTS**—Our new Student Ministries Director, Kyle Bartholic, leads this fresh ministry to middle and high school students, aimed at personal spiritual formation; growing in relationships with God, friends, and family; and discovering and following Christ's purpose for our lives.

**ADULT SMALL GROUPS**—small gatherings, short and longer term, of adults making friends, Bible study and application, spiritual growth, and a deepening discipleship to Christ.

**MEN AND WOMEN**—retreats, breakfast gatherings, service projects, theme-guided events—all for building good connections for mutual ministry and a healthy spirituality. Our women's 'W.I.L.D.' team leaders plan and coordinate an ongoing ministry for ladies. Annual retreats anchor these efforts for teaching and training for men and for women.

**TRAINING SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS**—In addition to participating in area-wide, regional events and teleconferences, CCF offers a varying selection of weekend and single-session learning events that are Bible-centered and life-related studies for personal, marital, and family growth.

**MISSION VENTURES**—Christ Community is partnered with a number of worldwide mission ventures. Annually, we also pray, plan, and carry out short-term mission projects, both regional and international, for our own people to experience, first hand, the joy of serving people and sharing God's love.

**EXTENSION MINISTRIES**—Our work in the Kingdom of God takes us into the surrounding areas and communities for personal and team ministry. Parachurch groups, community-based initiatives, and everyday care and investment in the lives of friends are all a part of God's great work.

**SERVICE ASSIGNMENTS**—Within the fellowship and ministry structure of CCF, there are a growing number of opportunities for each of us to give our time, talents, and gifts. Each of the service opportunities listed above needs good, volunteer staffing. We have an important part to play. Training, placement, and support are provided.

**FUN AND FELLOWSHIP**—The seriousness of the work we do is matched by the special spirit of the fellowship. We believe this work is meant to be enjoyed. We believe we are to enjoy one another. The relationships we are blessed by are a vital part of our Christian life and growth.
